3 REVIEW

3.1 REVIEW 2024 SCORING WORKING GROUP MINUTES

Niclas is from SWE not FRA. No further comments.

3.2 REVIEW 2024 CIA PLENARY MINUTES AND SWG ACTIONS

3.3 AX: RED PZ CALCULATION

Can we use the blue PZ calculation as a starting point? The current is a % of the PZ. if it's a large PZ, like a CTR, then the penalty is relatively light. We will ask the programmers of scoring software to program as an alternative calculation a new version: using Pythagoras for the 3D infringement meaning the vertical and horizontal infringement to the closest edge of the PZ (relatively doubling to blue PZ formula) with a maximum of 1000 pts.

3.4 CALCULATIONS OF PENALTIES FOR TIME INFRINGEMENTS

This was discussed in our pre-meeting. The decision was made to leave this as is: meaning out of time results in a NR.

3.5 GROUP B POINTS DISTRIBUTION

The points difference in group A for 1 meter can be much bigger than in group B which looks unfair with GPS results. Can we do something with the scoring software to make this fairer. Suggested is to maybe move the median but we need a formula to decide how far, which is a problem. For now we are closing this discussion, but welcome feedback. Note: this discussion started in 2018 proving it's a difficult one.

4.1 COLLISIONS AT LOW SPEEDS

We will ask the safety commission to have a look at this.

4.2 ANY NEW REFFERALS

- FRF: There was a question for the need of more info in the FRF. It was felt that if information is needed then there should be a titled box asking for that information. A suggestion is to make some fields mandatory. FRF and to add
 - TO / Landing Time
 - TO / Landing information (Type of field, Landowner. Text field)
 - Estimates
- Some clarification and best practice remarks will be added to the COH
 - If a marker is partly on the fabric of a cross or on tape scoring in or out will always be in favor of the pilot, this also needs to be clear on the TDS.
 - It has nowadays become best practice to hand out all the markers during the
 GB. Used markers during a flight will be on the table at the next task briefing
 - Make the TT aware that markers should not be removed before the last balloon has passed the target
 - Recommend pilots to use a camera, on top of the balloon, for extra

safety/awareness

Discussion about what a good vertical limit would be for limit 4 is forwarded to safety
