#### Comments:

The on site Jury members (Rina Gallo, Arnold Hohenegger) arrived 1 day prior the official arrival day and were accomodated at the same hotel as the other officials. The room for the jury was close to the Manifest and the FAI Controller. Short distances and a good communication plan (WhatsApp Groups) made communication with MD, FAI Controller and Chief Judge easy. To keep the remote Juror Ronald Overdyk up to date about the competition, and as close as possible to the on-site Jury members, WhatsApp was used for instant communication. Addionally the Jury held every day at noon a Zoom Meeting. Based on Bulletin 1 (item 16) the Jury approved the established jump order from the official start list for this competition (see Jury Notice 1).

Due to the difficult weather situation MD Marek Novy had to make many decisions regarding the program of events. The fact that the Skydiving World Cup Series (FAI SCE) was running concurrently did'nt make decisions any easier. In consultation with the CJ and FAI Controller the MD made correct and rule-compliant decisions. The fact that neither complaints nor protests were brought to the attention of the Jury proves that all Meet Officials did a very good job. According to Sporting Code Section 5 (3.1.3.5) the Jury handeled two (2) records and has sent the Preliminary Record Claims and Dossiers to the FAI Secretariat; the records are already ratified.

As the FAI Controller Gernot Rittenschober mentioned in his report some tasks in the FAI and ISC handbooks are redundant and required to be done by different ISC officials in parallel (see FAI Controller report for details)
